- Educating and incentivising our customers and their end users to make more sustainable product and material choices.

• Increasing awareness of climate change and improving the assessment of climate related risks including the development of appropriate mitigation measures.

- Valuing diverse skills and contributions by improving diversity and equality.
- Increasing the development of strategies which will be of benefit to human health and wellbeing.
- Improving and assessing our environmental performance by investing in training, awareness, systems and tools.

• We have begun calculating our full scope 1, 2 and 3 greenhouse gas emissions according to the PAS 2060 international standard. Currently we have set ourselves the challenge of offsetting those which are unavoidable through investing in accredited renewable energy / carbon offsetting projects or supporting reforestation efforts while our official figures are determined.

• Ensuring the suitability and effectiveness of our suppliers, and monitoring their performance, ensuring slavery and air miles form no part of our supply chain.

• Adhering to WCM&A Ltd's Health Safety Policy, ensuring a safe workplace for everyone and investing in all necessary staff training and equipment to maintain this.

• Maintaining our ISO14001 environmental certification, annually updating our Environment Policy and related environmental objectives and targets.

• Developing our Quality Policy and procedures to ensure we keep our ISO9001 certification and in doing so prove to our customers that our British manufactured products, with their lower carbon footprint, are items of choice.
